

MERGER DECISION NO 01: 2018

DECISION ON THE PROPOSED ACQUISITION OF 60% SHARES IN BMS (PTY) LTD, OFFICE TECHNIQUE (PTY) LTD AND RANGECOM (PTY) LTD BY e-AFRICA HOLDINGS, FROM BIDVEST OFFICE HOLDINGS.

PURSUANT to section 60(4)(a)(ii) of the Competition Act (Cap 46:09), notice is hereby given on the decision made by the Competition Authority ("the Authority") in respect of the proposed acquisition of 60% shares in BMS (Pty) Ltd; Office Technique (Pty) Ltd; and RangeCom (Pty) Ltd by e-Africa Holdings, from Bidvest Office Holdings.

The Authority determined through the analysis of the facts of the merger, that the proposed transaction is not likely to result in the prevention or substantial lessening of competition, or endanger the continuity of the services offered in the market under consideration. Furthermore, there are no negative public interest concerns that have been identified.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 55 of the Competition Act, the Authority has unconditionally approved the proposed acquisition of 60% shares in BMS (Pty) Ltd; Office Technique (Pty) Ltd; and RangeCom (Pty) Ltd by e-Africa Holdings, from Bidvest Office Holdings.

However, as stated under section 66 of the Act, this approval does not override or negate any other mandatory statutory approvals or processes that any of the parties to this merger must comply with under the Laws of Botswana.
