



## **MERGER DECISION NO 32 Of 2017**

### **Notice in terms of Section 60(4)(a)(ii) of the Competition Act**

#### **DECISION ON THE PROPOSED ACQUISITION BY ISUZU MOTORS SOUTH AFRICA (PTY) LTD OF THE ISUZU LIGHT COMMERCIAL VEHICLE BUSINESS, BEING A SOUTH AFRICAN BASED MANUFACTURING AND IMPORTING BUSINESS CONDUCTED BY GENERAL MOTORS SOUTH AFRICA (PTY) LTD.**

PURSUANT to section 60(4)(a)(ii) of the Competition Act (Cap 46:09), notice is hereby given on the decision made by the Competition Authority ("the Authority") in respect of the proposed acquisition by Isuzu Motors South Africa (Pty) Ltd of the Isuzu light commercial vehicle business, being a South African based manufacturing and importing business, conducted by General Motors South Africa (Pty) Ltd.

The Authority determined through the analysis of the facts of the merger, that the proposed transaction is not likely to result in the prevention or substantial lessening of competition, or endanger the continuity of the services offered in the market under consideration. Furthermore, no negative public interest concerns have been identified.

Pursuant to the provision of section 60 of the Competition Act, the Authority has unconditionally approved the proposed acquisition by Isuzu Motors South Africa (Pty) Ltd of the Isuzu light commercial vehicle business, being a South African based manufacturing and importing business, conducted by General Motors South Africa (Pty) Ltd.

However, as stated under section 66 of the Act, this approval does not override or negate any other mandatory statutory approvals or processes that any of the parties to this merger must comply with under the Laws of Botswana.
